


How to Access Wellmark's Drug List


When filling a prescription, the cost of your medication will depend on which medical plan you have chosen and which drug tier the medication is under (generic, formulary/preferred, or nonformulary/non-preferred). In addition, members enrolled in either Ruan's Basic or Choice Savings medical plans may have their pharmacy claims applied toward the annual deductible unless the drug is classified as a preventive medication.

To see which drug tier your medication is under, or if it is classified as preventive, follow the steps below to view Wellmark's Drug List.

1. Visit http://www.wellmark.com. Under *Individuals & Families* click "My Employer Provides My Insurance".




2. Click on "Prescription Drug Information".






3. On the left of the screen, click on "Drug List".




4. Scroll down and click on the "Blue Rx Complete" formulary list.






- From this page you may look up a medication two ways:
 - a. Type the drug name in the search field to the left of the screen




b. Scroll down and click on the "Printable Formulary" list.





6. Each medication will list the name, available dosages, and the drug tier the medication is under. Medications classified as "preventive" will have a code of **PV** under the "Limits & Restrictions" column.



<u>Tip to Save Money at the Pharmacy:</u> if your medication is under a higher cost drug tier, use the online search tool to find your medication. When you locate the name of your drug, click on "Find Alternative Drugs" to see a list of comparable — medications that may treat the same condition but are under a lower cost drug tier (i.e. a generic or a preferred name brand drug).
